#### SAGES Program Seminars (13 credit hours)

The First Seminar\* (4 credit-hours, to be taken in the first semester of enrollment): The First Seminar focuses on the development of critical thinking and communication skills through the use of a variety of approaches, media, and perspectives to explore the human mind and the nature of inquiry. This course is designed to strengthen writing and analytical
