 - Distance learning (asynchronous)
 - The Statistics Boot Camp (CE)
 - NUND 450 (statistics)
 - NUND 510 (informatics)
 - NUND 610 (evidence-based practice)
 - NUND 611 (DNP Practicum) NUND 615 (teaching practicum), NUND 619 (proposal development), and NUND 620 (DNP Project) do not have formal classes. Learning

DNP Program Academic Requirements

Overview Realizing DNP students have complex lives and many responsibilities; the faculty designed our program to allow flexibility in the order in which courses are taken and for students to work with the advisor to develop individualized program plan. There are, however, specific pre- or co-requisites for some courses which students are expected to follow, for example, NUND 504 and NUND 450 are pre-requisites for NUND 540.
