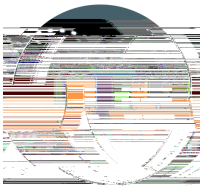


Food Security and COVID-19 in Cuyahoga County

Expand public transportation options.



Advocate for living wages needed for workers to meet basic needs related to food, housing, and other essential needs like health care and child care.



Develop new or coordinate with existing grassroots coalition(s) to mobilize policy changes that have direct impact on fair access to fresh and healthy foods.
