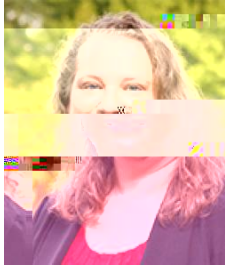


## -Care Success Story
